WHAT IS SAFETY CULTURE?

Safety Culture is the way safety is managed within a company, often reflected in two things:

Employee ATTITUDES, PERCEPTIONS, BELIEFS & **VALUES**

Company POLICIES, PROCESSES & PROCEDURES

It reflects the commitment to safety at all levels in the organization and how safely members of the organization behave on a day-to-day basis






